Vintro's is on the lookout for more reporters. The reporters should not worry too much about spelling, since the editors will fix it.

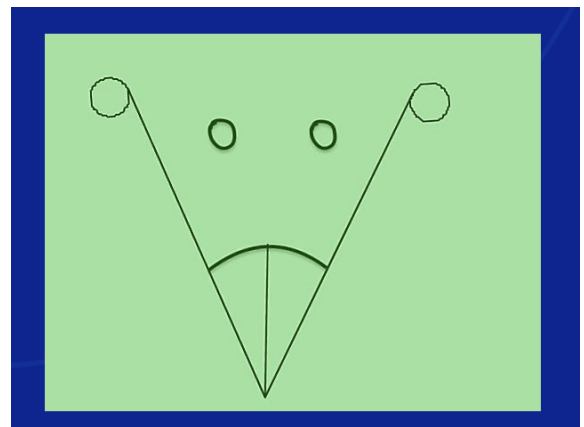
Reporters should be able to have some ability to spell or type. Preferably, the articles should be done online. Reporters are asked but not required to include a picture, maximum 2.

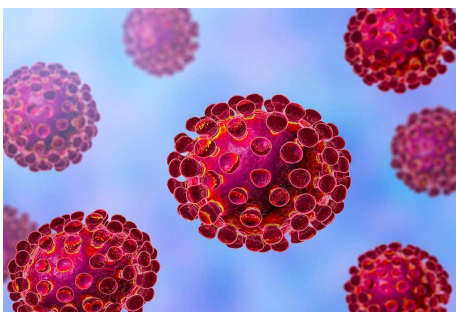
